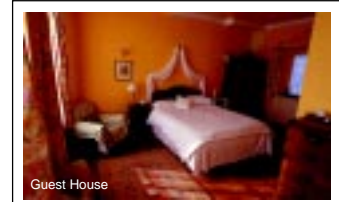

# Short Courses

## **1.a: Dressage / b: Show Jumping / c: Eventing.**

For both residents and non-residents these courses run from Monday to Friday, but can be joined for just a few days. Lessons can be on a school horse or your own horse. The course consists of two group riding lessons and a lecture each day. The group size is usually four but may occasionally be more. The riding lessons include exercises to improve the rider and to train the horse. For the *Dressage course* both of these lessons are flatwork; for the *Show Jumping/ Eventing course* the second lesson focuses on jumping. The lectures support and elucidate the lessons. Extra private lessons or lectures can be added and are recommended for specific individual goals.

**Suitability:** Minimum requirements are that riders are able to trot and canter, have a knowledge of basic school figures and can ride independently in a group situation. For the *Show Jumping / Eventing course*, riders must be able to jump 70cm from trot and canter. If you are inexperienced but want to learn to jump then join the standard dressage course and book some extra private lessons for the jumping. The *Dressage course*, is also suitable for those who prefer not to jump. A high level of fitness is not required. For those bringing their own horse a school horse can be hired for some sessions to give their own horse a chance to rest.

**Accommodation:** Is available in either the Guest House or the Chalet accommodation. Alternatively you may wish to travel in daily. Residential guests attending for the week usually arrive on Sunday afternoon to commence the course on Monday morning.

## **2.a: Summer Camp.**

For these courses arrivals are Sunday evening to start riding on Monday and finish after riding on Saturday. The duration of the course can be from one week to several weeks. There are two riding lessons each day leading to an internal dressage and jumping show on Saturday plus lectures that cover the care and training of the horse. Riders are welcome to bring their own horse / pony or use one of ours. For those without their own horse there is the chance to care for one of the centre's horses for the duration of the course.

**Suitability:** The age range on this course is usually from 13 to 18 years. Minimum requirements are that riders are able to trot and canter, have a knowledge of basic school figures and can ride independently in a group situation. A high level of fitness is not required. For those bringing their own horse a school horse can be hired for some sessions to give their own horse a chance to rest.

**Accommodation:** Is normally in the Chalets though it can be arranged in the Guest House for older or accompanied Summer Campers.

## **2.b: Intensive Option - Summer Camp.**

The intensive option gives you the option of adding an additional class lesson to the daily programme except on Saturday.

## **3.a: The Special Dressage Programme. (Mon - Fri)**

This course includes 12 lessons shared with only one or two other riders plus three private lessons. There will also be a lecture each day covering dressage training. Jane and Christopher will teach at least three of the riding lessons.

**Suitability :** This course is suitable for those with or without their own horse. If you come with your horse, it is possible to hire a school horse for some of the lessons.

## **b: The Special Eventing Programme / c: The Special Show Jumping Programme.**

This course is as per the Special Dressage Programme but with the emphasis on training for eventing or show jumping.

**Suitability:** This course is suitable for those with or without their own horse. If you come with your horse, it is possible to hire a school horse for some of the lessons.

## **4. Tailor Made Training.**

**Course Content:** These courses are suitable for everyone. Whether you are too novice to join a group, wanting help with your own horse, or just feel you benefit more from one to one tuition we can help you create a programme tailored to your specific needs. As with our other courses lessons can all be on your own horse, all on our horses, or a combination of the two. For those interested in long term competition training there is also the option of combining this with working towards BHS exams.

**Accommodation:** Can be either in the Guest House, The Chalet Accommodation or you can travel in daily if preferred.

**Prices:** The price for a Tailor made option consists of the "Accommodation" prices plus the "Lessons" and "Livery" prices if applicable.

## Holiday Bookings.

Payment of fees: The deposit (£50 per week, £10 per day) is payable with the application. A course can not be confirmed until this has been paid. A pro forma invoice will then be issued and the balance of fees will be payable one month in advance. We regret that no refund of fees can be made in the event of a course being cancelled or terminated before it is completed.

## Travel Arrangements.

# Vocational Training

## **Vocational and Competition Training.**

Tailored to meet your exact requirements and your budget. This could include additional training in riding or stable management or competition training and preparation. Training options vary in intensity and therefore costs range between no fees payable for a low intensity full working option but becoming more expensive the more formal training is required.

## **Working Student Option:**

Students wishing to be Working Students are required to be resident at the Centre. The work/practical training consists of caring for the horses in and around the stables and general yard work. Exercising, Schooling and Teaching practice may also form part of your training. You will also assist with other activities such as shows, demonstrations, exams etc. Those applying to do the Working Pupil options need to show evidence of previous experience looking after horses, and need to be physically capable of doing the work. For those from outside the European Union (EU), a student Visa will be required and the amount of work permitted is limited on such visas.

## **Own Horse:**

Students may bring their own horses with them on the course and are encouraged to participate in the shows that take place at the Centre.

If you are interested in exploring any of the training options please contact us by phone, fax or email providing details of your age, height, weight and previous experience together with your goals for this training and an indication of when you may wish to come. Please also provide contact telephone numbers and suitable times to call you to discuss the options. Alternatively complete the online form on our website.

## **Booking Fees & Payments:**

**A BOOKING FEE** of £200 is payable upon application. This fee is not a deposit and is not returnable except if an application is not accepted.

**Fees** are payable one month before the start of each term. No fees are refunded in the event of the course being cancelled or terminated before the course is complete. A credit charge of 2.5% monthly is payable on fees which are not paid by the due date. UK students wishing to pay by monthly installments in advance may apply to do so by Bank Standing Order but subject to a credit charge of 3%.

**A bedroom deposit** of (£100) is payable with the first term's fees and is refunded (less any deductions for breakages or damages considered by the centre management to be unacceptable).

**Examination fees** are payable to the British Horse Society and payment must accompany the application to the BHS. An allowance of up to £600 should be made to cover this. For further details check out the BHS website ;([www.bhs.org.uk](http://www.bhs.org.uk)). Students are entirely responsible for ensuring that they are qualified to take the exams for which they are intending to apply. In all cases, ultimate responsibility lies with the applicant to ensure that all membership and exams are entered and paid for well in advance. Spaces in exams are limited and are reserved strictly on a first come first served basis and therefore we recommend booking at least three months in advance.

**Livery fees** are payable monthly in advance. Livery extras such as feed, shoeing, veterinary charges etc. are invoiced at the end of each month and are payable within 28 days. A credit charge of 2.5% monthly is payable on overdue accounts.
